Your company's application for laboratory certification and the accompanying documentation from NELAP was received by the Division of Waste Management, Underground Storage Tank Branch on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Based on the documentation provided, Xenco Laboratories, is hereby granted certification to perform analytical testing related to Kentucky's Underground Storage Tank Program. This certification covers Benzene, Toluene, Ethylbenzene, Xylene Lead, PAH, Oil & Grease, Ignitability and PH. Xenco Laboratories must advise underground storage tank owners or operators and Kentucky certified contracting companies of limitations on approved analytes. The granting of this certification is authorized under KRS 224.60-130(2)(a) and 401 KAR 42:340. Accreditation by A2LA or NELAP must be maintained in order to retain your UST Branch laboratory certification.

You are advised that your company's certification can be revoked or suspended for those reasons specified in 401 KAR 42:340. You are further advised that a lab certification must be renewed every two (2) years in accordance with 401 KAR 42:340, which in your company's case, will be 02/25/10. It is suggested that a renewal application be submitted to the UST Branch at least 30 days prior to the expiration date.
