RE: Laboratory Approval for XENCO Laboratories - Atlanta

Dear Ms. Kuruganty:

Xenco Laboratories - Atlanta requested a stipulation that XENCO Laboratories is an accredited laboratory to perform environmental analytical work in Georgia. This letter provides such approval.

Please note that the Georgia Environmental Protection Division does not accredit or certify commercial laboratories (other than for drinking water) or issue certification, but rather we require commercial environmental laboratories to be approved under our Rules for Commercial Environmental Laboratories. XENCO Laboratories provided documentation (Certificate E87429) that their laboratory is accredited by the State of Florida, Department of Health, Bureau of Laboratories (hereinafter, "Florida"), in accordance with NELAP. The accreditation is in the categories of Environmental Analyses for non-potable water and for solid and chemical materials.

After reviewing the information provided from XENCO Laboratories and the attached documentation from Florida, approval is granted under our Rules for Commercial Environmental Laboratories for those individual parameters within the categories of (1) Non-potable Water and (2) Solid and Chemical Materials, which is certified by Florida. This approval is valid through June 30, 2011, which is the expiration date of the accreditation. To be approved after that date, XENCO's accreditation must be renewed.
